### PROJECT SUNDAY LOOKS AT HISTORY THROUGH FILM

The Chicago History Museum kicks off Project Sunday with a film on Maxwell Street Market

**WHAT:** **Project Sunday** is a new monthly documentary film series at the Chicago History Museum held in collaboration with ITVS and Kartemquin Films. The films are free with Museum general admission. All films begin at 1:30 p.m. and are followed by a discussion.

The first film in the series is *And This Is Free*, a candid and raw film revealing the multicultural texture and rhythms of Chicago's Maxwell Street Market. The film is 50 minutes in length.

**WHEN:** Sunday, September 16; screenings begin at 1:30 p.m. followed by a discussion.

**WHERE:** Chicago History Museum, 1601 North Clark Street (Clark and North Avenue).
