### MIKE DOUGHTY HEADLINES PLAY CHICAGO ON OCTOBER 12

#### Concert opens with Anna Fermin's Trigger Gospel

**WHAT:** *ComEd Powers* PLAY CHICAGO, a concert series at the Chicago History Museum in partnership with 93XRT. The Ed Paschke exhibition will be featured for this concert and will be on display for all concert goers for the first 90 minutes. This concert is a 21+ ages show.

**WHO:** **Mike Doughty**, former front man of the world-renowned group *Soul Coughing* will play music from his new album, HAUGHTY MELODIC. Doughty's songs have a colorful ornamented sound that combine the melancholy and psychedelic; with such tracks as "Madeline and Nine," "Grey Ghost," "Busting Up a Starbucks," and "Looking at the World from the Bottom of a Well."

The concert opens with Anna Fermin's Trigger Gospel. This band combines country sounds with elements of pop and rock. This Chicago-based band has been around for 6 years, and will open the PLAY CHICAGO show at 6:00 p.m.
