Design an Advertisement

READ:

Get your hot dogs here! Advertisements show people why a product is special or useful. The best advertisements make it more likely that people will buy that product. Some advertisements are funny, some are informative, some are surprising. How good of a job do hot dog advertisements do? The National Hot Dog and Sausage Council estimates that Americans eat 20 billion hot dogs a year! That's a lot of dogs!
