PLAY CHICAGO PRESENTS THE REDWALLS ON APRIL 12 Live show at the Chicago History Museum opens with *Air This Side of Caution*

WHAT: *ComEd Powers PLAY CHICAGO*, a concert series at the Chicago History Museum in partnership with 93XRT. For the first 90 minutes, guests can enjoy the Museum and view the exhibition, *The Essential Art Shay: Selected Photographs*. *ComEd Powers PLAY CHICAGO* is a 21+ ages show.

WHO: The PlayChicago stage welcomes the Redwalls, a Chicago band featuring vocalist/guitarist Logan Baren, 22, vocalist/bassist Justin Baren, 21, vocalist/guitarist Andrew Langer, 21, and drummer Ben Greeno, 21. This up and coming band is known for hit songs such as *Build A Bridge*, and *Thank You*.

Air This Side of Caution is opening for the Redwalls. Closely associated with the Indie Rock genre, the sound they produce is rapidly morphing the musical landscape of Chicago. Recently, they have played alongside OK GO, Michael McDermott, The Webb Brothers, and Assassins, as well as such notables as Bon Jovi and Jon Mellencamp.
