

Volunteer School Group Greeters

Do you have a positive and enthusiastic personality? Are you looking for ways to express your love for Chicago? Are you interested in working as part of a team to provide quality museum visit experiences for school groups, ranging in age from pre-K to high school?

The Chicago History Museum is seeking volunteers to interact with our school group visitors. Volunteer Greeters assist paid Museum staff in welcoming groups, providing wayfinding, and sharing knowledge of the Chicago History Museum and the city of Chicago.

- Volunteer Greeters work in two locations at the Museum:
 - Welcome and orientation in west lobby and Crown Room: guide groups from orientation to gallery, performance, or classroom destinations
 - Second floor lobby and L Car #1: provide wayfinding and other information to students, chaperones, and teachers
- Experience is not necessary! Training will be provided.
- Proficiency in a second language is a plus.
- Volunteer Greeters are scheduled Monday–Friday, 9 a.m.–1 p.m. weekly, at least one day per week.
- The Museum welcomes youth and school groups year-round. Peak school visit months are October–December and March–June, followed by summer camp groups in July.

The deadline to apply is September 30, 2021. Training begins in November 2021.
