


Write a Top-Notch Thesis Statement that Uses the Theme



SAMPLE

History Day Theme = *Turning Points*
Narrow Subject: Battle of Gettysburg

Historical Question: How was the battle of Gettysburg a major turning point of the Civil War?

Working Thesis Statement: The Battle of Gettysburg was a major turning point of the Civil War. It turned the tide of the war from the South to the North

Final Thesis Statement: The Battle of Gettysburg was a major turning point of the Civil War. It turned the tide of the war from the South to the North pushing back Lee's army that would never fight again on Northern soil and bringing confidence to the Union army.
