Student Awards for 2021

CMHF is proud to announce the first-ever “HISTORY FAIR IN ACTION” AWARDS!

These student awards recognize outstanding projects that address historical topics that directly connect to present day issues of identity, equity, and local history.

All students competing in the Chicago Metro History Fair Regional Contests are eligible to self-nominate their projects for consideration in these awards during project registration. One project from each division (junior division and senior division) will be selected for each of the awards listed below. All project categories, both individual and group projects, are eligible.

Each student with a recognized project will receive a monetary award up to \$100 as well as recognition on the CMHF website and in our virtual awards event in April 2021.

- **History in my Backyard Award:** Projects that incorporate the student’s own identity, family, or neighborhood.
- **Power of the People Award:** Projects that highlight activism or organized protest for social justice and equity.
- **United We Stand Award:** Projects that focus on local/community organizations, especially in Chicago.
